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## Overview

Commission Junction's product catalog functionality allows links to your products to be available to the entire CJ Marketplace, or a select few publishers if desired. Product links enable you to integrate buying opportunities directly within relevant content for immediate purchasing opportunities. For example, on a Web site about the Caribbean, a publisher could place a CD of Caribbean music from an online record vendor somewhere in an article about the native music. Whoever is reading this content is already interested in the music and has a higher chance of actually purchasing the product offered. This is called buying at the point of interest. Adding product links to your Commission Junction program lets content providers place your products within the context of their content and create impulse buying opportunities for visitors. Product catalogs are currently in use by many top rewards sites, comparison shopping sites and shopping mall sites within the CJ Marketplace.

Setting up a data transfer subscription with Commission Junction enables you to transfer your product catalog data in an ASCII file for import into our system. The product information you transfer will be available as content providers search for links within the Commission Junction product catalog (you may request to remove access to your catalog in publisher searches upon request, however). Should your inventory change or if products become unavailable for a period of time, you can simply transfer additional files reflecting the changes.

This document provides an overview of the steps involved in preparing your file and implementing data transfer according to the formats and methods supported by Commission Junction. The online help provides information on product management within the *CJ Account Manager*.

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## Subscription Set-up Overview

The file must contain certain values in a specific format to be recognized by the Commission Junction system. These values and other settings are part of your subscription, which determines the data transfer specifications. Additionally, Commission Junction configures your data format and transport method of your data transfer results to the recommended default. Commission Junction contacts you to obtain the necessary information to configure your subscription.

**Note:** *(Regarding Re-Integration)* If you are currently integrated in the CJ Marketplace and switching from standard to item-based data transfer, ensure your tracking allows for the 7-day period in which publishers may decide whether to accept the new terms associated with the action change.

For example, a publisher can refer standard actions for the first 3 days of the 7-day period, accept the new program terms on day 4, and refer item-based actions thereafter. Your data file submissions for this period must include data for both actions—in essence, a double reporting of action data. The Commission Junction system determines which records in your data files are applicable and disregard the remainder. This ensures that all referred actions are properly credited.

## Standard v. Gateway Advertisers

In the Commission Junction Network we categorize Advertisers in two ways during the integration of their program: Standard or Gateway. Please refer to the definitions below.

- **Standard Advertiser:** This is a client who tracks every transaction occurring on their web domain through Commission Junction. This client also does not have any unique points of entry or Gateway entry into their Web domain in order to enable tracking for a Publisher's commission payment.
- **Gateway Advertiser:** This is a client who does not display or track every transaction occurring on their Web domain through Commission Junction; rather, this client implements a Gateway. A Gateway is defined as a unique URL string and/or name=value pairs embedded within a URL string designed to trigger Commission Junction's tracking mechanism enabled on your end.

### More Information for Gateway Advertisers (Only)

If you select to be a Gateway client, you must add the Gateway URL string and/or name=value pairs needed within them to the URL destinations uploaded to the Commission Junction ad serving system to enable commission based tracking. You may complete this by using your CJ Account Manager>Manage Links area. The system will deny your URLs upload if the appropriate Gateway URL string and/or name=value pairs do not exist. These pairs are required in order for the tracking session for Commission Junction referrals to be valid.

If you do implement such functionality, you are required to identify all returning customers referred by Commission Junction if they leave your web domain and return within the minimum time frame defined within the Action Referral Period of your Program Term. This period cannot be less than 24 hours. This is part of your agreement with Commission Junction.

If you implement a Gateway on your Web domain, you are not allowed any other link types other than banner ads and text links. Restricted links types for Gateway advertiser are as follows.

- Advanced Links
- Smart Links
- Content Links
- Product Links/Catalogs

If you implement a Gateway and an advertiser is interested in allowing publishers to utilize or any of the link types in the restricted area above or link redirection, they will have to implement a Gateway which can perform what we call URL redirection.

If you wish to respond to the information above, access the **Contact Us** link and click the Check Question Status **Go** button. Select your incident by clicking the **Update** button, and input your response.

Once your request is logged, our Technical Support Team contacts you within 48 hours with implementation instructions for your URL redirection integration.

## Supported Transfer Methods

Once your data is collected, reviewed and formatted to Commission Junction specifications, your data can be transferred in an ASCII file to Commission Junction via one of the following methods:

- **email:** Advertiser emails data file to Commission Junction.
- **Commission Junction FTP:** Advertiser transfers file via FTP to Commission Junction FTP server.
- **Client FTP:** Advertiser makes file available on client FTP server for Commission Junction to access.
- **HTTP/HTTPS:** Advertiser makes file available at a specific URL for Commission Junction to access.

**Note:** Export files are left on the CJ FTP/HTTP/HTTPS server for 30 days (7 days for products).

Successful import files are archived for 120 days (2 days for products). Unsuccessful (error) import files are archived for 30 days (3 days for products).

**Note:** Your ASCII file must contain specific values and formatting to be processed by the Data Transfer system. Refer to Content Guidelines and Format Guidelines for specifications.

# Content Guidelines

## Character Sets

Commission Junction supports the following default character set for transferred files:

- Microsoft Codepage 1252 (includes 7-bit ASCII, ISO Latin 1, and several additional characters)

Commission Junction supports a handful of other character sets in addition to Codepage. For delimited formats (pipe, tab or comma), the header of the file must contain an ENCODING field to enable our system to process a non-default character set (see table below). For XML format, a non-default character set must be specified before the file’s header (see Data File Examples).

## Header Fields

The following table lists the header fields (both required and optional) and ordering that are supported for inclusion in your ASCII file you transfer to Commission Junction.

MULTIPART	<p>Enables advertisers needing to split one catalog AID into multiples files the ability to do so and send them at the same time. You must send all files in the batch at the same time and if all files are not received on the same day, the system does not process any files from the group. The numerical value you enter is the total number of files included in the batch.</p> <p>Example: &amp;MULTIPART=4</p> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p><b>Note:</b> All files included in the batch should indicate the same &amp;MULTIPART=# field, otherwise the subsequent file you send will overwrite the previously sent file. If you only provide characters that fall within the default set (Microsoft Codepage 1252, including ISO Latin 1 and 7-bit ASCII)—and do not require strict adherence to a particular set—this field is optional. PARAMETERS	<p>Specifies the body parameters you provide in your file. At minimum, it must include the parameters marked as Yes in the Required column of the Body table. ## Body Fields

The following table lists the body fields (both required and optional) and ordering that are supported for inclusion in your ASCII file.

**Note:** Some field names listed in the following table appear as multiple words (e.g., the field name PROMOTIONALTEXT appears separated into PROMOTIONAL and TEXT in the table), however in actual use, all field names must be one word. Do not use spaces.

- Numbers in parenthesis in the Data Type column represent the maximum number of supported characters. If there are two numbers, the second number indicates the maximum number of decimals allowed in the value. For example, (10,2) indicates that 8 digits are supported before the decimal and 2 after (for a total of 10 digits).
- If you provide data that exceeds the stated maximum character length for the following parameters, the system will truncate the data to the character limit:
  - Name
  - Keywords
  - Description
  - Promotional Text
  - Warranty
- The required parameters (NAME, KEYWORDS, DESCRIPTION, SKU, BUYURL, AVAILABLE, PRICE) must be provided in the body of your file and listed in the PARAMETERS portion of the header. Any non-required parameters you provide must also be listed in the PARAMETERS list.
- Pipe characters ( | ) are not supported within any values.

**Note:** Do not include characters in your data that break your import format (e.g., CSV data including commas, TAB data including tabs, etc.).

**Important:** It is strongly recommended that in addition to the required parameters, you include the following optional parameters to better optimize your results.

- **MANUFACTURER** (name)
- **MANUFACTURERID**
- **UPC** (If applicable. Not appropriate for international.)
- **ISBN** (If applicable. Only valid for books.)
- **ADVERTISERCATEGORY:** Use a > value for a delimiter and provide a complete drill-down path (i.e., tools>hand tools>hammers. If you do not include the ADVERTISERCATEGORY parameter, publishers will not have search capability. Publishers like the ability to pick and choose products by category. Using this field with a certain level of depth can only improve the ability publishers to promote advertisers via those product links.

**Important:** In order for Commission Junction to credit the publisher correctly for past referrals, you must assign the catalog item to an item list at the time the action occurs. We recommend you use the INSTOCK column of the product catalog to notify the publishers of out of stock items, but still keep products in their catalog for the duration of your referral cookie, in order to credit publishers for past clicks. After a period of time, use the available column to remove the product from the product catalog and item list.

## Publisher Notes

### Notification of Link Changes

Please note that if you remove a product or change the Buy URL value, you must notify the publishers using the link to ensure that their site code reflects the changes.

### Product Data Feed

In addition to importing product data from advertisers, Commission Junction also exports product data to qualifying publishers (online shopping malls, comparison shopping sites, etc.) for the advertisers who have made their catalog available to them. Product data feeds to publishers have the following differences from the advertiser parameters:

- PROGRAMNAME: Name of the advertiser program.
- LASTUPDATED: Informs the publisher of the date of the most recent update to the product.
- IMPRESSIONURL: Impression tracking code. This is an image tag for a 1x1 pixel that uses the product's Ad ID and the subscription's Web site ID.
- AVAILABLE: Not provided in publisher feed.

## Format Guidelines

Commission Junction supports the following data file formats for imports and results reports.

- Pipe-delimited
- Tab-delimited
- Comma-delimited (CSV)
- XML (eXtensible Markup Language)
- Name/Value (for results reports only)

This section provides simple import examples of the supported formats, along with a list of general guidelines for each. For additional examples, see the Data File Examples section.

**Important:** Additional product records in delimited formats can be added with a line break between each. Additional records in XML format are added as described later in this section.

The file examples in this section contain line breaks within product records for readability purposes only (space limitations prevent records from being shown on one line in this document). Individual records must be continuous with no line breaks. See the guidelines later in this section for further details.

## Pipe-delimited

In the example below, not all of the available parameters are applicable to the product (ISBN, Author, Artist, etc.), and are therefore excluded from the header and body. If you select the Pipe-delimited format for product data imports and results reports, and an error generates, the failed record displays an exclamation mark (!) as a replacement for any Pipe (|) characters in the original record.

**Note:** Although supported, pipe-delimited format causes frequent errors. To avoid errors, choose another format if possible.

## Requirements for XML Formats

- Your XML file must conform to the requirements of a well-formed XML document. The official specification is located at <http://www.w3.org/TR/REC-xml>.
- XML tags are case-sensitive.
- Parameters that are not applicable to your file need not be included in the file.
- Additional products are added by simply inserting additional sets of tag pairs and values (<product></product>, etc.).
- No control characters (including tabs) or extra spaces may be used within brackets.
- The following characters may not be used without special commands: > < & " ' '
- Pipe-delimited is not a valid character for XML.

If you need to use one or more of the above characters, the commands in the table below enables you to use them.

## Transferring Your Data File

Commission Junction supports a number of options for transferring data files—Commission Junction FTP, Client FTP, Client HTTP, Client HTTPS and email. Please note the following.

- It is advisable to update your product information in the Commission Junction Product Catalog as often as possible. Remember that you must always provide unique product SKU numbers with a product's information.
- As stated earlier, if you have a product that is no longer available for purchase, submit the product with the Available field marked NO. Should the product become available at a later time, submit an updated product catalog data file. The product does not appear as available in the product catalog until you submit a file with the Available field marked YES.

**Note:** All subscriptions begin in a test mode. Commission Junction works with you to verify successful transfer before enabling live transfer.

## Commission Junction FTP

This method allows you to transfer the file to Commission Junction's FTP server, which is enabled by establishing a Commission Junction FTP account. We provide you with the Commission Junction FTP server address, along with a username, password and any further instructions.

Once you successfully log into our server, place your ASCII file in the default root directory. Do not create a new folder or navigate to a different path—this prevents our system from processing your data.

**Note:** Successful import files are archived for 120 days (2 days for products). Unsuccessful (error) import files are archived for 30 days (3 days for products).

## Client FTP

If you choose to place the file on your FTP server for Commission Junction to access, you must:

1. Provide Commission Junction with the following information:
  - FTP Address
  - User
  - Password
  - Directory (if applicable)
  - Port (if applicable)
2. Deliver files to your server with unique filenames (such as a time stamp) to enable accurate processing.
3. Delete the file from your server upon receiving confirmation of a successful import via the results report (described on the next page).

**Note:** Commission Junction does not support data transfer via FTPS (or other variations of FTP with SSL).

## Client HTTP/HTTPS

If you choose to make your file available at a specific URL for Commission Junction to access, you must provide the necessary URL information. The system performs daily checks of the URL and 'pulls' and processes the file if it has changed since the last import (determined by the last modified date of the file as recorded on your server). Your HTTP/HTTPS server must have a stable clock, and the timestamp of the file must reflect the actual time of modification. Please ensure that any failover servers you may have do not interfere with incoming HTTP/HTTPS requests. For information regarding the use of HTTPS and acceptable certificate authorities, refer to Appendix B: HTTPS Use and Acceptable Certificate Authorities.

## Email

If you choose this option, simply email your data file to [import@datatransfer.cj.com](mailto:import@datatransfer.cj.com).

You can submit the file in one of two ways:

- as the body of the email
- as a MIME attachment: please limit attachments (files) to one per email

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## Results Report

Once you transfer your data file, Commission Junction sends an import receipt confirmation email prior to processing. Once a data file processes, you receive a confirmation (or rejection) report. Your results report format and transport method depends on which data format (Name/Value, TAB, PIPE, CSV or XML) and transport method (Email or CJ FTP) you selected during setup. If you choose email as your transport method, you receive an email containing the results report in your selected data format. If you choose CJ FTP as your transport method, you receive an email confirming import, an email confirming your data is available via CJ FTP, and the results report on CJ FTP.

The emailed or CJ FTP-ed results report details information relevant to the file provided, and displays the information in the format you previously selected. If you selected email as your transport method, the results report displays in the Additional Message section of your email. Regardless of the transport method selected (Email or CJ FTP), a completion email sends to the email address(es) specified in the import subscription settings and displays the following information.

- Time of processing.
- Total records processed.
- Total errors.

If you select Email as your transport method, the completion email also includes the following information.

- List of transferred records, which provide the result for each record. Any records that did not process successfully will indicate the reason for the error.

**Note:** If you select CJ FTP as the transport method, the system delivers the list of transferred records via CJ FTP, in the specified format.

The most common stem of an error are incorrect or missing headers. If you receive an error, correct the problem and resubmit. If you need further assistance, contact Technical Support.

**Note:** You may view the status of your data transfer by accessing your *CJ Account Manager>Account>Services* area.

## Appendix B: HTTPS Use and Acceptable Certificate Authorities.

Commission Junction supports the use of Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) protocol and HTTPS for data transfer. Secure transfer via HTTPS requires the use of certificates for authentication of the data and parties involved. Certificates are signed by trusted agencies called Certificate Authorities to ensure the validity of the certificates. Commission Junction requires the following for successful transfer via HTTPS.

- The server must present an SSL/X.509 certificate whose Common Name (CN) matches the DNS host name.
- The certificate must be certified by a chain that ultimately is certified by one of the accepted Certificate Authorities.
